Expanding its scope beyond child-centric issues, the organization has diversified its initiatives to include women's health programs, medical camps, and the promotion of awareness regarding various social issues such as child marriage, child protection, and sanitation. 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
Gray denotes the figure approx. **population** while blue denotes the **actual reach on a monthly basis**. Everything else corresponds to this month.

Happy New Year 2026 Celebration






National Girl Child Day, 25 January 2026

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
